The class of this vessel is subject to a special Survey equal to a Half Time Survey being held at four and eight years from date of build, to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied and to the longitudinal girder over main stop valve being examined for clearance above same when convenient.

The Naples Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and the requirements of a Special Survey, equal to a Half Time Survey complied with, but the marks on 30 fathoms of cable now placed on board, require to be compared with the certificate of test.

The outside planking and decks have been recaulked as necessary.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with fresh record of Survey 3-22 and notation of S.S. Mes. 22 subject to a Special Survey, equal to Half Time Survey being held at eight years from date of build, to the 30 fathoms of cable now placed on board being again examined and the marks on same compared with certificate or the cable retested and to the longitudinal girder over main stop valve being examined for clearance above same.
