Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 13th instant respecting your Steamer "T. H. SKOGLAND" ex "JAVARY", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them the reports of survey held by the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg on this vessel, and have assigned to the Steamer a class of 100A1 "Shelter Deck with Freeboard", subject to the anchors and cables being compared with their certificates of test and found in order, together with notations of s.s. No. 2-21 and LMC 8,21.

At the same time, I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of yesterday as follows, viz:-

"Have instructed London Joint City Bank credit you
"140 pounds account THSKOGLANDS classification",

and, in thanking you for your prompt attention in this matter, I have to say that the cheque for this amount has come to hand from the Bank to-day. I also confirm my cabled reply to you as follows, viz:- "Thanks for cablegram T.H.SKOGGLAND classed 100A1 "Shelter Deck with Freeboard subject anchors and "cables being compared with certificates of test "and found in order".

In connexion with the completion of the survey of the equipment, I return herewith the test certificates for the anchors and cables of this vessel, and shall be much
