I duly received your letter of the 27th ultimo relative to the fees to be charged in certain cases, and upon inquiry I find that since writing your letter you have been advised of the amount of the fee to be charged in the case of the "HAMBURG".

As regards the "T. H. SKOGLAND" ex "JAVARY" it is noted from subsequent correspondence that the freeboards assigned by the Committee will be marked on the vessel's return to your port, and the fees for the complete classification should be charged by you as follows, viz:- Hull - £100, Machinery - £30 and Assignment of Freeboard - £10, making a total charge of £140.
