Nature of Survey

It is submitted before this case receives consideration the Surveyors be requested to state whether:— The deep tank has been examined ~~and tested~~; they have specially examined the riveting of the butts of the side and bottom shell plating; they have satisfied themselves regarding the pillaring arrangements and construction of the cargo doors; the thickness of the centre girder and ^{of the} shelter deck plating in way of the openings are as approved; the anchors and chain cables have been tested by Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd; they are correct in stating the chain cables have not been ranged in view of the particulars of tests etc., being entered in the First Entry Report.
