SURVEY REPORT - S.S. "JAVARY".

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT I, the undersigned, did
at the request of the Commander of the s.s. "JAVARY", Official No.
143356, and with the sanction of the Local Agents, proceed on
board the above vessel to examine port main boiler reported
defective.

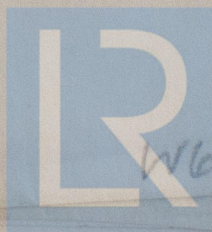
ON EXAMINATION I FOUND the saddle and wrapper
plate seams in all combustion chambers leaking, also several leaky
rivets on same. The combustion chamber stays are leaking, also
several smoke tubes, three of which are cracked at mouth.

R E C O M M E N D A T I O N S.

I RECOMMEND THAT defective rivets on saddle and
wrapper plate be cut out, plates to be drawn up and ~~xxx~~ reriveted
and caulked, nuts on leaky stays to be taken off, stays caulked,
new washers to be fitted & nuts refaced, split tubes to be cut out
and new tubes fitted, and leaky tubes re-expanded.
