This vessel was reported to have gone ashore near Hakodate on 18th June, and it was stated that there was little prospect of salvage.

A special casualty letter was sent to the Owner on 13th July, but no reply has yet been received.

The Kobe Surveyors state in a letter dated 8th October that they have been advised by the Hakodate Surveyors that the vessel has been abandoned as a total loss.
