Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant enclosing a copy of one you have received from the Owners of the motor vessel "TROLLTIND" respecting the question of the continuance of the vessel's classification with this Society, and to say that the same was read to the Committee at their meeting to-day.

In view of the fact that the Owners at the moment have not yet determined whether the vessel's classification with this Society will be continued, and of the fact that the vessel is at present laid up indefinitely, the Committee have agreed to defer action until the end of August, by which time it is hoped that definite information will be forthcoming as to what action the Owners propose to take.

As you are aware, the annual survey of the oil engines is very much overdue, and the vessel's class is continued subject to the crank shaft of the port air compressor being renewed, and to the donkey boiler being repaired.
