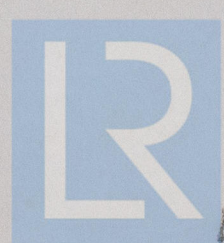

J.W.Whittall & Co.Ltd., Lloyd's Agents and with consent of the owners proceed on Sunday 26th instant on board of the British screw steamer "RIO PRESO" of London No.71362 in the Register Book, vessel lying afloat at the examination anchorage Leander's Tower, for the purpose of ascertaining nature and extent of damage sustained through collision with the British screw steamer "BELGRAVIAN" stated to have occurred on the 25th instant whilst vessel was proceeding to an anchorage at Leander's Tower when it is stated vessel collided with the steamer "BELGRAVIAN" which was lying at anchor, and for the purpose of making an estimate of time and cost for the repairs and it is the opinion of the undersigned that the time necessary would be about three to four days and the cost about TWO HUNDRED pounds sterling (£200), for particulars of which see damage report.
