Boilers 506-7.

We thank you for yours of 3rd. inst. re. the above Boilers, the contents of which we have noted.

Since submitting the plan to you, the owners have asked us to do away with the lower of the wing stays at the side of the furnaces, and we would alter the position of the other stay as shown on the plan and increase its diameter. We also propose to put nuts on the three stay tubes marked on plan, instead of the doubling plates required. We will be glad to know if these modifications meet with your approval.
