Dear Sirs,

I duly received your favour of the 9th inst. from which I am pleased to learn that you desire to retain the classification of your Trawler "MATSUKAZE MARU" and I have today telegraphed to our Surveyors at Nagasaki requesting them to hold the Boiler Survey before the vessel leaves that port. It is noted that you did not understand that this survey was due and in this connection I beg to draw your attention to an extract from the Society's Rules which is printed on the back of the Engine and Boiler Certificate which states that the Boilers must be surveyed when six years old and thereafter annually. This is a very desirable precaution as it enables any small defects which may develop to be attended to readily thereby frequently saving extensive repairs.

I have telegraphed you today as follows:- "SHALL ARRANGE HOLD BOILER SURVEY YOUR STEAMER MATSUKAZE NAGASAKI PLEASE NOTIFY YOUR AGENTS THERE".
