With reference to your letter of the 28th ultimo I have to inform you the steamer "ISSORIA" is still laid up at Venice.

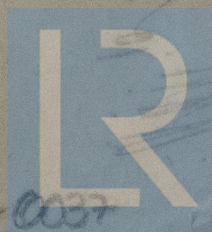
The owners' Superintendent stated that should the vessel be put again into commission they will without fail arrange for any outstanding surveys to be carried out before the vessel proceeds to sea.
