R. Williamson & Sons, and is classed 100A1 in the Society's Register Book. Her gross tonnage is 400, net 111, and the Owners are the Builders.

I may say that the particulars of the vessel are at present being posted in the Register Book and will appear in the next supplement. The delay in publishing this information has been due to the fact that the steamer has only recently been named.

With regard to your enquiry respecting the dredgers "OCTOPUS" and "WALRUS", I beg to explain that it is not the Committee's practice to record particulars of dredgers in the Register Book unless they have been built for classification therein, or special application has been made by the Owners for them to be inserted.
