British steamer Galava, coal cargo,
employed in coasting trade, foundered off
this coast last night; reported that several
lives were lost.
Sydney, Feb. 9.—The coastal
collier Galava foundered at midnight off
Terrigal. Seven men are at present
missing.—Reuter.
GALAVA.—Sydney, Feb. 10.—Steamer
Galava foundered off this coast. Seven
of the crew drowned.
