This trawler went ashore under  
Bempton Cliffs on 12th October; bottoms badly  
delved and plates opened all along the  
edges, but not holed; she is high and dry  
at low water.

The Hull Surveyors state they are  
informed by the Owners that the vessel  
is now a total wreck.

31st December 1923

The Owners now state that the vessel  
has been "totally abandoned"

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

DRITE.—Bridlington, Oct. 12.—  
Trawler Alexandrite, H 726, ashore  
on Cliffs. Crew left vessel. Brid-  
lington fishermen on board. Vessel making  
little water. Ground very rocky, so  
light from the north, tide taking off.  
Presume went ashore high water 5 a.m.  
to-day.—Lloyd's Agent.

Flamborough Head  
Oct. 12.—Coastguard Speer  
trawler Alexandrite ashore on  
Cliffs. Crew left vessel  
in own boats.

ALEXANDRITE.—Bridlington,  
Steam trawler Alexandrite, H 726, was  
visited on Oct. 12 and found to be  
bottom badly delved and plates opened  
all along the edges, but not holed. The  
vessel was taking water in the engine  
room, and the tide flowed in freely. The  
forepart of the vessel, from the engine-  
room bulkhead, seemed fairly well  
tight. The vessel is high and dry at low  
water. She has not been visited since  
owing to the ground swell.

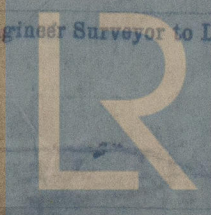
