This vessel was built in 1916 and classed with Germanischer Lloyd.

The London Surveyors now report the vessel has been placed in dry dock and examined generally.

The indented plating, previously reported, examined and found efficient.

Nos. 1 and 2 keel plates from aft found slightly set in.

The riveting and caulking have been overhauled. The efficiency of the vessel being unaffected permanent repairs have been deferred.

*The vessel will probably be submitted for a classification survey at a later date.*

From the examination now made the Surveyors are of opinion that the vessel appears to be in a fit condition to run for a further period of six months from October 1920.

It is submitted notation of Lon.10.20 be assigned.
