Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to some trimming holes in 'tween decks being permanently closed.

The Marseilles Surveyors report that on account of damage, through collision, the vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned & coated, the stem partly removed, faired & refitted, 9 shell plates, 7 frames & 3 floors removed, faired & refitted, 3 shell plates & 2 stringer plates faired in place, and minor repairs carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 7.19, subject as above.
