
In reply to your enquiry contained in your letter of the 24th instant, respecting the case of the steamer "MOYALLON", Glasgow Report No. 38865, I have to inform you that as in this case the fees chargeable to the Builders in accordance with the rules are in excess of what would have been charged under the special agreed scale for standard vessels no fee will be charged to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding in respect of the work carried out under their instructions, up to the time of the transferring of the vessel to private ownership.
