The reason why the steam test and floating of valves have not been carried out, is that the Marine Board Certificate is dated from then and for the same reason she has not been dry-docked.

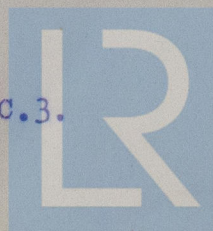
