

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH MESSAGES ARE RECEIVED BY THE COMMERCIAL CABLE COMPANY.

The Company may decline to forward the Message, though it has been received for Transmission; but in case of so doing shall refund to the Sender the amount paid for the Message.

The Company will refund to the Sender the charges paid by him—

- (a) For any Telegram which fails to reach the Addressee through any neglect or default of the Company or its Servants, whilst the message remains under the control of the Company.
- (b) For any repeated Telegram which, owing to errors made in transmission by the Company's Servants, has manifestly not fulfilled its object.
- (c) For every Telegram in plain language which has manifestly been unable to fulfil its object, in consequence of errors made in its transmission, unless the errors have been pointed out by paid Service notices.

Whatever may be the damage caused either by errors, mistakes, delays, mis-delivery, non-delivery, or otherwise, in respect of any Message entrusted to the Company for transmission, whether the same arise from the neglect or the default of the Company's Servants, or howsoever otherwise the same may arise, the Company shall not be liable except to refund to the Sender the amount paid to the Company for the transmission of the Message.

The control of the Company over the Message shall be deemed to have entirely ceased at any point where, in the course of the transit of the Message to its destination, it may be entrusted to any other system, service, or line of telegraph.
