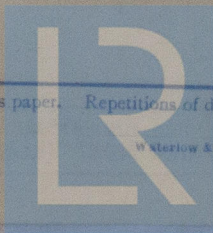

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH MESSAGES ARE RECEIVED BY THE COMMERCIAL CABLE COMPANY.

The Company will decline to forward the Message, though it has been received for Transmission, but in case of so doing shall refund to the Sender the amount paid for the Message.

The Company will refund to the Sender the charges paid by him:

(a) For any Message which, though any defect or default of the Company or its Servants, has manifestly not fulfilled its object.

(b) For any Message which, owing to errors made in transmission by the Company or its Servants, has manifestly not fulfilled its object.

(c) For every Telegram in plain language which has manifestly been unable to fulfil its object, in consequence of errors made in its transmission, unless the errors have been due to the language used either by error, mistake, delay, or mis-delivery, or otherwise, in respect of any Message entrusted to the Company for transmission.

Whether the amount paid for the Message shall be refunded to the Sender or the Company shall have full power so to instruct the Message for further transmission to any other system, service, or the destination, it is left to the discretion of the Company.
