S/S "Bingera"

This vessel is owned by Messrs The Australasian United Steam Navigation Co^{ltd} & was built under special survey in 1905 & classed 100A1. Her Engines consisted of 3 Steam turbines.

The Owners possess 20 vessels all of which have been built to Class with the Society, but in accordance with their request the Class in each case is allowed to lapse when the S.S No. becomes due. In the case of this vessel the Class was withdrawn in 1910.

In August 1913 the Committee authorised the Glasgow Surveyors to undertake the special survey, during construction at Messrs McKie & Baxter Works, of 3 sets of Triple Expansion Engines which when finished were to be shipped abroad & fitted on board the vessel in place of the turbines.

The Engines have now been completed & the report on same forwarded to this office, a report has also been received from the Greenock Surveyors on some Engine Seatings which together with the Engines will be sent Brisbane to be fitted on board.

It is submitted that Copies of these reports be sent to the Brisbane Surveyor for his information who should be requested to ascertain whether it is the Owners' intention to re-class this vessel. If the vessel is not to be re-classed then the Surveyor should advise this office when the new Engines have been fitted in order that a record of NE (in black) may be assigned & the necessary alterations made in Column 13 of the Register Book.
