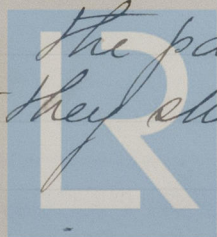

I have to acknowledge

chain cables supplied will be approved
for the figure 1.

With regard to the last paragraph
of the letter, requesting me in future to
endeavour to forward particulars of
equipment supplied to vessels, a day
or two prior to the morning on which the
Classing Committee meet, I respectfully
beg to inform you that I did not
delay forwarding the particulars in
question, so that they should arrive

Classing Committee were to meet, but I
forwarded them immediately I found
that they were not strictly in accordance
with the requirements of Table 22, so
that, in the event of the Committee not
approving of the 150 lbs of chain cables
which are under the Rule weight, others
of the required weight could be obtained
and placed on board before the vessel
sailed, and I respectfully submit that
this is in accordance with Par. 12 of
the instructions to Surveyors.
