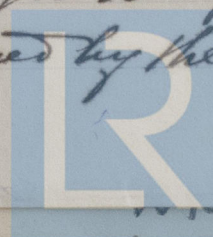

The Boilers in this case were made from their design and to their order by Messrs Lindsay Burnet & Coy and the working of them comes under their guaranteed as Contractors for the whole vessel complete.
