NO. 1569 SHIP.

We have contracted to build for the Port Line Ltd., to your classification, a twin screw motor-ship generally similar to our No. 1515 ship "Port Jackson" but of one frame space increased length, thus making the length B.P. 498'-3" instead of 495'-6". The extra frame space is to be added in the machinery space. The plans you have already approved for No. 1515 ship, will therefore in general apply to the new vessel, but to keep matters in order we are sending you herewith (in triplicate), for your approval, copies of the midship section, profile and deck plans, stern frame plan and rudder plan, upon which we have added the new number of ship and the alterations to the length and numerals. It is also intended in the new ship to have the butts and seams of the tank top plating welded.

We further enclose copy of freeboard particulars for a preliminary freeboard assignment showing the modified length and displacement and a slight correction involved to the intermediate
