Dear Sirs,

I duly received Mr. Pilditch's letter of the 10th instant enclosing a plan in duplicate of the new foremast and gear for heavy loads, the plan submitted in this case proposed to be fitted in the S.S. "PATAGONIER" to support a 30 ton derrick, and with regard thereto I am directed to state, as in the case of the sister ship "MENAPIER" referred to in my letter of the 3rd instant, that while the Committee of this Society do not take any responsibility of approving masts and gear for heavy loads, the plan submitted in this case has been examined and certain modifications made to the scantlings which are considered desirable, and that with the arrangements as shown and amended it is considered that the mast will be suitable to carry the derrick in question, upon the assumption that the mast is supported by stays which are taut and efficient.

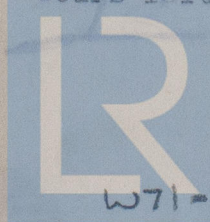
One copy of the plan in question is returned herewith, and the duplicate is being retained for reference.
