I am directed to acquaint you that in accordance with the arrangements at present in force for the substitution of Special Periodical Surveys by successive General Examinations at twelve-monthly intervals, a General Examination for maintenance of class of the above-named vessel will require to be held before the end of **April next** and I shall be glad to learn, for the information of the Committee, when and at what port it is proposed to submit her for the requisite inspection.

At the same time I think it well to remind you that the vessel's Freeboard Certificate will expire on the **22nd April, 1941** and you will doubtless wish to arrange for the necessary Freeboard Survey to be held in conjunction with the above General Examination, with a view to the renewal of this certificate.
