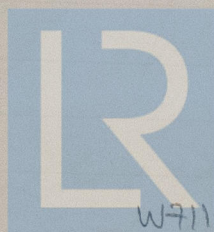
It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Surveyor should be requested to state the name of the Machine at which the cables were tested, and why these were not tested by a Surveyor to this Society, as required by the Rules.

His attention should also be called to the ^{breaking} ~~proof~~ test given as 123500 ^K instead of 124400 ^K as required by Table 31, and he should be requested to forward the ^{proof} ~~breaking~~ test applied, as this has been omitted from the report.

He should also be informed it is concluded that the thickness of the bridge deck is 10 ⁱⁿ and not 9 ⁱⁿ as stated on the report.
