In reference to your letters of 26th ult & 1st inst, regarding the new Steamer " ROSALIA L. ", we beg to acquaint you that on the evening of 2nd inst we received a wire from the Owners asking us to proceed to Palermo to make the necessary Survey as the vessel had to leave again on the 4th inst. -

As the journey to Palermo requires about 36 hours, we wired & wrote the Owners to say that it was not possible to hold the Survey within the time at our disposal. -

They reply saying that the vessel is chartered by the Administration of the State railways & left Palermo after a very short stay & that they will advise us of the vessel's return & at what Port the Survey can be held. -

We shall be glad to have Instructions about the Engine Survey at your convenience. -
