Dear Mr. Scott:

With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo and to Galveston report No. 697 on the steamer "WAR MARVEL" I enclose herewith a letter dated the 16th instant received from the Surveyor from which it will be seen that the vessel was constructed with two water-tight bulkheads, one at the fore peak and one at the fore end of the cross bunker.

The survey on the hull and machinery was completed on the 19th of August 1918.

The Surveyor also states that in future cases the thickness of the diagonal planking and the scantlings of the steel middle line keelson will be noted on first entry reports.

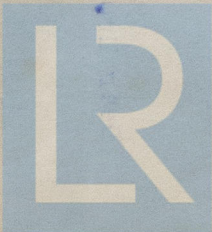
