This vessel was built by Messrs. The National
building Co. at Orange, Texas, for Messrs. The
rd S.S. Co. and is classed 10 A.1. She was completed
918.

The vessel has two laid decks, a long poop and
castle. The machinery is fitted aft, bulkheads are fitted
the fore and after ends of the machinery and a collision
head^{is}/also fitted. Two bulkheads are fitted about midway
ween the Collision and Machinery Bulkheads, these two
kheads extend only to the 2nd Deck and were originally
ended to form a deep tank for the carrying of water
last.

The stem and stern post are of oak, the remainder of the/
timber
the structure being of long leaf Yellow Pine.

The centre keelson is of steel plates and angles.
keel, floors & beams are of the usual type used in wood
sels. The outside planking is reinforced by 2^{diagonal} thicknesses of/
next the timbers
nking, each 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " thick and fitted/at right angles to one
ther. The ceiling is edge bolted from lower turn of
ge to upper deck, the wales being also edge bolted.

The rudder is of single plate type with cast
el frame. The gudgeons for receiving the pintles are
cast steel and are connected to the wood stern post with
e through bolts 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " diameter clenched at each end.
