With reference to your letter of the 19th ultimo, and to the case of the steamer "WAR KNIGHT", San Francisco Report No. 2525, I enclose herewith a letter dated the 16th instant, received from the Surveyors at San Francisco, from which it will be seen that cargo battens were fitted in the shelter 'tween decks of this vessel, and that the breaking test of the steel wire supplied, in lieu of stream chain, was fifty-nine tons.
