H. Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Christiania Surveyor recently reported that the Steamer "WINGA" had sustained damage through grounding and recommended that permanent repairs should be effected on her arrival in this Country. The temporary repairs have been recently examined by the Society's Surveyors at Hull, with a view to the Vessel proceeding to the Tyne, Wear, or Tees for permanent repairs, and the Surveyors recommend that these be effected at the earliest opportunity.

I have therefore to request that you will give the case attention should the Steamer arrive in your district, and advise me promptly, in order that the Reports on the case may be forwarded to you for your guidance.

I may add that it would appear from the Hull Surveyors' Report that the Boiler Survey has been completed.
