Damage cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he is required to state whether he offered his services for this purpose and why they were declined? Not required, Interim Cert. Was a damage report made by anyone else? If so, by whom? None made.

PAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Seaworthiness: Examined all temporary repairs stated to have been effected at Christiania on account of vessel grounding in the Vestergapet Channel, Norway, on the 14th Decr 1914. Interim certificate was given for the passage from Hull to the Tyne, Ber or Lss whereon dry dock could be obtained in order to carry out permanent repairs.
