I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of S. to-day's date, respecting the S.S. "WINLATON", in the case of which the Special Survey No. 1 became due in March, 1916, and has not yet been completed. I have, however, to point out that in connexion with the survey of the vessel in dry dock at Belfast in April last, a record was made in the Society's Register Book of "Examined 4,17", as provided for in the Circular letter copy of which I have the pleasure to enclose; and you will note that, in the circumstances, a further examination does not become requisite until a period of six months from the date of the last one - that is to say, until October next.

I trust this will make the matter clear.
