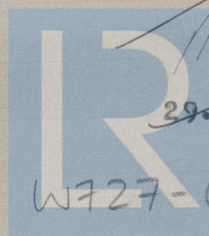
Remarks of Survey

The Rotterdam Surveyors report this vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned & coated & rudder pintles renewed.

The main piece of the rudder which was found to be more or less grooved at the arms, have been repaired by electric welding to prevent further corrosion.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 9. 19, subject to the main piece of the rudder, where repaired by electric welding, being specially examined at the next dry docking.
