



In February last the owner stated the screw shaft was drawn when the vessel was at North Shields in August last, but that it was not seen by the Society's surveyor. In the circumstances the owner asked that the matter might stand over for a time. In reply to inquiry the owner now states the vessel is employed running pigiron from Middlesbrough to French Munition Works and back again with loam from the Thames to Middlesbrough for the Munition Works there. The owner adds he does not want to stop the vessel unnecessarily but he is entirely in the hands of the Committee and will be

pleased to hear what he should do in the matter.

The following is an extract from the report of the survey held by the Newcastle Surveyors in August last :-

"It is stated that the tail shaft (C.L.) has been drawn

"for the shaft to be examined at this time, being ~~drawn~~
