H. Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant respecting the steamer "TEESBOROUGH" and in reply I have to say that in the circumstances the Committee who had the case of this vessel before them at their meeting to-day are agreeable to the survey of the screw shaft being postponed for the present. I think it well to inform you however that it would appear from the report of the Surveyor who surveyed the vessel in August last that no opportunity was given him to examine the work in connection with the drawing of the tail shaft and the rewooding of the lower half of the stern bush and that your Superintendent informed the repairers it was not necessary for the shaft to be examined at this time as it had been drawn in in connection with the rewooding of the bush.


