The Owner states that this shaft was drawn when the vessel was in Baird's Dock, North Shields in August last. Before it was drawn the Superintendent had to go away on urgent business and relied on Messrs Baird's informing the Surveyor when the shaft was ready for inspection but this they failed to do. In the circumstances the Owner asks that the matter may stand over for a time. The vessel is at present carrying pig iron to French munition works and coming back with foundry loam for controlled works in this country. The shaft has a continuous liner. (continued)
