The class is subject to indented plating being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.


The Newcastle Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated.

Alterations have been effected to the after engine room bulkhead and tank top, new reverse frames fitted to floors in way, for installation of Bauer-Wach turbine.

The indented plating referred to above has not been dealt with.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 8.30, subject as above, as recommended.
