Remarks of Survey


The Glasgow Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has left for that port, and to complete the survey the following requires to be done:— Forecastle deck to hose test, forward Downton pump to repair and try on bilges.

The following defects found on shelter deck in testing to be made good:— Some holes in waterway to plug, 1 winch fairlead to lift & rebed, flush coaling scuttle to repack, a few studs, deck bolts & dowels to fit. Points of cross bars (Thief bars) in ventilators to set up.

Scupper pipes, etc. in No. 5 main 'tween decks to case with wood.

The Belfast Surveyors should be requested to forward approved plan of the after peak, framing, etc.
