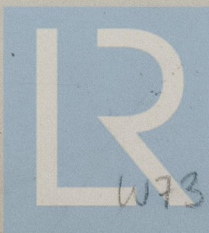

- (1) The Contra Flo attachment for the condenser, which is being supplied by The Contraflo Co. has not been fitted in place.
- (2) The Metallic United States Packing has not been fitted to the H.P. Piston Rod and H.P. Valve Spindle.

The Makers state arrangements are being made for this work to be completed on arrival of the engines in Canada.
