With regard to the fees charged for the engines and boilers, I have to refer you to my letter of the 31st ultimo and to request that you will render an amended account in accordance with the arrangement set forth in that letter. You will observe that in this instance you should charge £6-10-0 for the survey of the boilers and £6-10-0 for the survey in connexion with the fitting of the boiler, the fee of £14-0-0 for the survey of the engines being credited to the Sheffield Surveyors account.
