Nature of Survey

Equipment

The Hull Surveyors report that a new Bowser Anchor of correct weight & test has been supplied & also 45 fathoms of Chain Cable, to replace equipment lost in Humber in December.

The diameter of the Chain Cable now supplied is $1\frac{1}{16}$ ", against $1\frac{1}{8}$ " originally supplied & approved for these barges.

It is submitted for the consideration of the Committee whether the new cable might be accepted. The vessel allowed to remain a classed.
