**H.M. TRAWLER "RESPARKO" SUNK**  
An official Admiralty communique issued on Saturday announced that H.M. minesweeping trawler *Resparko* (Temporary Skipper J. Fountain, R.N.R.) sustained damage as a result of enemy air attack and subsequently sank. There was no loss of life. The *Resparko*, of 248 tons gross, was formerly owned by Mr. G. F. Sleight, of Grimsby. She was built at Beverley in 1916.
