Dear Sirs,

I am duly in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant, respecting the steamers "CONDOR", "DRONT" and "WORON", and in compliance with the request contained therein I have the pleasure to enclose herewith copies of reports of survey held on the "CONDOR" at New York in March, 1917, on the "DRONT" at Barry in March 1917, and on the "WORON" at Shields in May 1917 and at Cardiff in August, 1917 - together with an Account for the cost of the same.

With regard to the "CONDOR" the following remains to be done to complete the Special Survey No. 3 : the ceiling to be lifted and the lower bunkers to be examined, then double bottom tank to be tested in way of the same.

The Special Survey No. 2 of the steamer "DRONT" was carried out in March last, but the vessel retains her class subject to the shell plating, which was damaged by fire, being permanently repaired at the first favourable opportunity.

With regard to the "WORON" the Special Survey No. 2, which became due in July, 1914, has been held with the exception of some permanent repairs which require to be effected to the shell plating, frames etc., and some permanent repairs

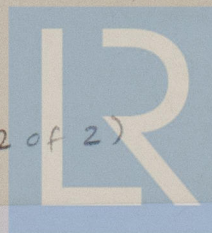
