
Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th instant, enclosing one dated the previous day from Messrs. W.W. Nicholas & Co., relative to the fee of ten guineas, (£10.10s.) charged in connexion with the general examination and damage survey held last month on the steamer "WORON".

In reply, you should point out to the Owners' --Superintendents, that in the case of this vessel, the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Special Survey No.2 expired so long ago as July, 1915.

In the present exceptional conditions, however, the Committee have been agreeable to the further postponement of this and other periodical surveys, which it has been found impracticable to complete, subject to a general examination being made, with a view to the condition of the vessel being ascertained and reported upon, and this examination, when satisfactory, is recorded in the Register Book. The fee of ten guineas, (£10.10s.) charged in the present instance is for the general examination, and is in accordance with the practice at present.

It will be well for you to remind the Owners' Superintendents that in addition to the examination of the


