The Surveyors should be requested to point out
Owen Superintendent that the year of grace allowed
the completion of the Special Survey No 2 expired as
ago as July 1915, and that in view of present conditions

such cases, as a condition of the further postponement
the completion of the Special Survey, the vessel to be
submitted for a Special general examination as has
been done in this instance, and that the fee of 10 guineas
charged for this examination, is in accordance with the usual
practice. They should also inform the Owen Superintendent that
in addition to the Examination of the lower bunkers & the testing
of the E.R. some flaws & weaknesses in this tank require to
be repaired before the notation of S.S. No 2. can be made.
