ANSWER.

On the 27th. February last it was reported that fire had broken out on board the above vessel, and that she was aground near Carnero Point, Gibraltar. It was stated that she had been burnt to the water's edge. I shall be glad if you will be good enough to let me know for the information of the Committee how the case now stands.

The above steamer referred to was burnt to the water's edge and was declared a total loss. The Wreck was sold for £420 and the cargo on board at the time for £60.
