Key

The Gibraltar Surveyor reports (27th February) damage through straining when loading iron ore. Part of the cargo was discharged, the vessel examined in dry dock, and the following repairs effected:— Butts & seams of outside planking recaulked, fastenings overhauled, and some additional stiffening fitted.

The vessel was undocked, and when partly reloaded, found to be badly on fire. She was towed out of Admiralty waters, subsequently went ashore, burnt out to the water edge, and became a constructive total loss.

In the circumstances, no action is necessary on this report.
