Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of inquiry, regarding the Screwshaft of the S/T "Responde" now owned by Messers Llewellyn & Yolland, I have had word from the firms Engineer that they are in communication with Messrs C.D. Holmes & Co of Hull, asking them if they will do the job,

As there is not a firm here who can do a job of this size, beside being a long delay, I am seeing Mr Llewellyn tomorrow 17th, & will advise him to ask C.D. Holmes if they can supply anew shaft with a continuous liner, it will be cheaper than delaying the Vessel for a fortnight, to get this shaft out, sent to Hull, skim, and shrink a liner on. I will press for this to be done as quickly as possible.

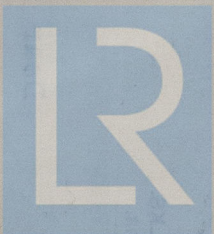
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
